



Behaviour Principles

Following the guidance laid down in the DfE Guidance for Governing Bodies on Behaviour and Discipline in Schools, the governing body agreed the following Behaviour Principles on which the school behavior policy will be based:

- Good behavior is expected within our school
- Effective systems of sanctions and rewards will be used throughout our school
- The needs of the individual child will be taken into account when choosing sanctions and rewards
- Members of staff may use reasonable force or physical contact where necessary provided it is in accordance with the school Positive Handling Policy
- Members of staff can confiscate and retain pupils' property where it is deemed inappropriate or being used in an inappropriate manner.
- Members of staff can discipline pupils beyond the school gate where their actions may bring the school into disrepute
- Safeguarding of our whole school community is paramount when considering any issue of behavior and discipline.
